

**COVENTRY TOWNSHIP - FISCAL OFFICER REPORT**  
**2012 BALLOT ISSUE - PRIMARY ELECTION, MARCH 6, 2012**

The Coventry Township Board of Trustees approved the following ballot issue for the March 6, 2012 Primary Election.

**Renewal of 1.00 Mill Existing Road Levy**

1. This levy was first put on the ballot in 1992, and was last passed as a renewal in November 2006. Township residents voted against the replacement and increase of this levy that was placed on the November 2011 General Election ballot. This existing levy currently expires in tax year 2011, with its last collection year in 2012. The Township will be forced to drastically cut its current road maintenance program *without* this levy. Increasing costs for salt, hot mix, fuel and oil used in the chip and seal program have made it increasingly difficult to continue with our past road maintenance programs. In addition, severe weather last winter and spring caused numerous road and drainage issues. If passed by our residents, this levy would be effective tax year 2012, with its first collection in 2013.
2. There will be NO additional cost to our residents for this levy. It is estimated that this levy will continue to provide approximately \$134,644 annually.
